Garrison administration and staff will review ISAT data, Explore and Plan data from the previous school year.</li> <li>3. Administration will review Illinois Alternate Assessment data and individualized data on students in the Multiply Disabled programs.</li> <li>4. Reviewed data from the previous year will be used to drive planning decisions for future school year and will be presented to the Operating Board annually.</li> </ol>

Director will post quarterly newsletters on website during the school year.</li> <li>2. Each department will post informational articles on the website each semester of the school year.</li> <li>3. Administration will conduct parent workshops in the member districts during the school year.</li> <li>4. Communication will be reviewed by staff and presented to Operating Board a minimum of two times per school year.</li> </ol>

The cooperative will have member districts complete needs assessment annually.</li> <li>2. Administration will review class lists and schedules for effectiveness and efficiency each school year.</li> <li>3. Information from each department will be presented to the Operating Board annually in the spring.</li> </ol>
<b>Professional Development</b>	Four Rivers will provide educational expertise to its member districts and stakeholders.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The cooperative will have member districts complete needs assessment annually.</li> <li>2. Administration will review numbers from August in-service and in-service trainings through the school year and use this information for planning annually.</li> </ol>
